Meeting Minutes

2026 JOQ's

- For 2026 JOQ's – All goals and balls cost \$3,900. The 2025 total was \$4,300.
- The JOQ HS Girls seeding meeting only took 22 minutes for 31 teams.
- HS Girls pool facility situation: Jason said all is okay.
- Tom Davis announced the HS Boys seeding meeting is Monday evening on May 18th.

Upcoming 8U Mixed "Mild Mayhem" Event

- This is a bronze level membership event for Saturday, May 30th.
- Thus far, 9 clubs have expressed interest

Coaches Advisory Committee

- Seeding is going well. 3-week grind to get schedules and JO quals completed.

Referee Report

- Rosenthal reported that HS Girls, there will be Friday games at 4 pools.
- Possible impact: So-Pac moved their youngsters to our JOQ Younger's weekend
- Historically both zones have tried to keep JOQ Youth dates away from same weekend
- Chris Jimenez wants more money for referees to officiate the Coastal CA Zone JOQ's
- Pacific zone gave a bonus for JO quals. Central might be doing the same
- Weaver foresees a domino effect
- Brennand - assigner didn't want referees jumping zones for more \$\$\$
- Brennand- referees must be willing to be mentored
- Weaver wants extra training helping develop referees
- Checks on deck- should use Arbiter
- Revenue reporting. Using Arbiter way to go consensus
- Raymond Bueche – So-Pac also wants more mentoring and evaluating of referees

Adjournment

A motion to adjourn the meeting was given by Michael McMahon and seconded by Tom Davis, and a 5-0 unanimous vote was recorded. The Chair thus adjourned the meeting at 9:17pm. Next meeting is June 17th.

Coastal California Zone Board Meeting Minutes

June 16, 2026 – 8:33pm

Call to Order

- Weaver, Davis, McMahon, Rosenthal, Roth were in attendance. A Quorum was declared

Treasurers Report

- As of 6-15-2026 current balance = \$238,706.41. Pending JOQ expenses, include:
 - HS Girls Oxnard facility
 - HS Boys (6 pools x 3 days)

2026 JO Quals Discussion

- Gate fee was an issue at certain sites.
- Pasadena and Rosebowl issues
- Distance between JOQ Youth sites was significant
- Some teams traveled over an hour between games
- 12U and 14U are our largest groups
- 10U Mixed and 12U Mixed are separate from the 14U Boys
- Zone is experiencing a record number clubs and entries for JOQ's.
- We had more expenses however we had more teams to offset the expense.
- Moving forward – Should we raise entries from \$850 to \$1,000?

Considerations for 2027 JO Quals bids

- Should we consider paid scheduling?
- Some coaches billed the zone for scheduling time.
- Need to be clear on what gate fees cover and what the zone pays for.
- There were inconsistencies that will lead to problems.

JOQ Youth

- Should we compensate for desk workers?
- We received a bill for \$3,400 for JOQ Youth desk workers from Commerce.

JOQ HS Girls

- Kelsie at Santa Barbara covered the pool charges. Her billable reimbursements were. Clocks 300, 160 wristbands, 100 wall posters. She paid money for desk workers out of Gate revenue.

JOQ HS Boys

- South Coast Matt Warshaw
- Paid site directors \$700. In addition, paid \$700 for Westlake, \$700 Camarillo, and Newbury Park \$700
- Discussion about the quality of referees and various issues that we encountered at JOQ's.
- We paid money for out of state and country referees
- Issues were discussed regarding the decorum of referees.
- What is the process for bringing in referees to Coastal Zone JO Quals?
- Some officials were deemed substandard
- The zone incurred overtime issues at 3 pools for 3 hours a day
- This costs the zone money @\$200-\$250 per hour. The zone estimates paying extra \$5-6K in extra pool fees.
- This also impacts site workers, lifeguards, janitors and supervisors.
- Question: Was there an instructional meeting for referees prior to JO quals?

Moving Forward

- Should there be a separate assigner for JO quals?
- There were procedural challenges that caused unplanned extra time and money.
- Question: What was the availability of referees? For some reason referees were not assigned.

- 14 Under level - referee problem when the referee left the game.
- Could we have used some So-Pac referees?
- Zone Head Referee was paid a total of \$3,579 in assigner fees for all 3 JOQ weekends.
- McMahon: "Scott Brennand has been the fairest assigner that he has ever worked with."
- Training referees – What can we do as a zone? Training vs. Organizing the tournament as two separate issues.
- Zone is the customer in the arrangement and the referee assigner needs to get the best assignment possible.
- Can we get feedback from coaches?
- USAWP Ryan Cunnane – The zone assigner and JO Quals assigner can be separate positions.
- Weaver brought up the idea of a paid evaluator position.

8U Mixed "Mild Madness" Event

- 11 Coastal zone teams attended
- Brandy Mosteller did a great job
- Over 100 8U Mixed players
- USWP briefly posted when given the information.
- The next event will be in August
- Weaver proposed to raise zone allocation of funds from \$1,000 to \$1,500
- Vote was taken and 5-0 in support.
- Need to promote on social media, however zone is in agreement that we should not have someone with bias to one club. Careful who we choose to do this.
- Led into discussion that we should have Wendy do this for our zone?

Old Business

- Boys and Girls Super finals coming up.
